Options & Rates

Registration Fee holds place & covers cost of materials. Fee of \$100 per child or \$125 per family

Early Bird Discount - \$75/child before 3/31. Prices in parentheses are for 2-year old classroom and non-potty trained 3-year olds. Potty trained means no pull ups and independent in bathroom.

Enrollment Definitions

Full Day = 4.5 to 9 hours

Half Day = up to 4.5 hours

Preschool (ages 2-5) = 8-11am only

Minimum of 1 full day, 2 half days or 2 Preschool days per week (3 preschool days for 4K)

Rates based on an 9-hour day or less. Any child staying longer than 9 hours will be billed an additional \$10/hour, per day, per child.

Extended Care Program (After-School for school agers)

Families choose set days of the week, with charges being \$7/hour for 3 hours after school (ex. Pick-up before 4:00 - \$7, before 5:00 - \$14; before 6:00 - \$21).

Summer Rates

\$7/hour scheduled by the week
