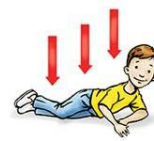

Below are some ways that you can continue to support Holy Trinity.

Shop With Scrip

Scrip is fundraising while you shop. Here's how it works: a family will buy a Scrip gift card through our school's Scrip program. You'll pay the full face value, but earn an immediate rebate percentage for Holy Trinity that's typically between 3% and 15% depending on the retailer. Then they use that gift card on your normal purchases. See Laura Dwyer to get your cards and for a listing of retailers who participate.



Box Tops for Education

The Box Tops for Education program helps us earn money for our school. Simply clip the Box Tops logo stamps from any participating product. Each box top is worth 10 cents. For a list of products with the box top logo, go to www.btf.com. Place your Box Tops in the container in the Narthex or drop them off in the school office.



Piggly Wiggly Receipts



When you shop, save your Piggly Wiggly receipts. Ask your friends and relatives to save their receipts too! Holy Trinity receives a percentage of the total amount spent. Place your receipts in the container in the Narthex or drop them off in the school office.

Goodsearch & Goodshop

Goodsearch is a simple way to make a difference. Each time you search then shop online (at 2800+ stores on Goodshop), a donation is made to our school. Visit www.goodsearch.org and select **Holy Trinity Lutheran Church and School** from the list of participating organizations.

Milk Moola (Kwik Trip)

Holy Trinity earns 5 cents for every milk cap and bag top submitted. The amount submitted gets paid by check to the school after every submission of at least 1,000 milk caps or bag tops. Sizes include bags, gallons, ½ gallons, quarts, pints, and ½ pints. Sizes do vary per product – always be sure to look for the Milk Moola logo on the cap or bag top. Place your milk caps or bag tops in the container in the Narthex or drop them off in the school office.
